Letter formation will be explicitly taught and refined this term.



Creative Curriculum

This year we have a focus on Britian throughout our whole curriculum.

We will be learning about some fascinating people/places/things in all areas; science, art, history, geography.

Our overarching topics are;

Once Upon a Time - an exploration of storytelling and traditional tales.

Ready Steady Grow, where we will observe how things grow and change.
