Creative Curriculum

Great Britain

Humanities: History - Exploring historical events, landscapes and people around the topic Anglo-Saxons and Vikings

Art - Artist: Kev Munday

This term we will explore this modern artist inspired by people-watching and the everyday and observe how he uses bold lines and block colours.

Science - Compare and group together different kinds of rocks and describe in simple terms how fossils are formed. Scientist: Mary Anning

Daily book band reading and guided reading sessions.

Reading for pleasure and class reader story time. Regular spelling practise and weekly testing.

Maths

Arithmetic practice and fluency fact work to develop speed and fluency in the key facts we need to remember.
