



Our School Uniform

It is our policy that children wear school uniform. In addition to giving children a feeling of belonging to their school, it is also more practical for parents. We also believe it is important that certain activities are facilitated by specialised and appropriate clothing when attending school, or when participating in a school organised event outside normal school hours. Aims

Our policy for children's school uniform is based on the belief that a school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Engenders a feeling of community and belonging
- Is practical and smart
- Identifies the children with the school
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents
- Has been designed with health and safety in mind

Our colours are grey, royal blue and white and the uniform is as follows:

Boys

- Royal blue sweatshirt with or without school badge
- **Grey** trousers or grey shorts
- White polo shirt with or without school badge or shirt
- **Black shoes**

Girls

- Royal blue sweatshirt with or without school badge
- Royal blue cardigan/jumper with or without school badge
- Grey skirt / pinafore or grey trousers
- White polo shirt with or without school badge or shirt
- Blue gingham summer dress
- **Black shoes**

For PE all children need

- White crew neck t-shirt with or without school badge
- Blue PE shorts – unbranded
- A pair of trainers for outdoor PE
- Plimsolls for indoor PE
- Navy tracksuit for outdoor PE – with or without school logo - unbranded

Please note as our children wear their PE kits to school on their PE days PE kit should not be any other colour than our uniform colours.



Football kits and branded sportswear is not permitted to be worn on these days.

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in school, with the exception of stud earrings. These should not be worn to school on days when children have PE. Please note staff cannot remove any earrings for children.

Make up and Cosmetics

Make up and cosmetics are not considered appropriate or consistent with our school uniform.

All clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled with your child's name
